EDUCATOR OF THE YEAR AWARD – OFF SITE

Objective: To recognize the important contributions made by attending physicians in educating resident physicians.

Eligibility: This award is to recognize educational excellence in attending physicians based primarily outside of the two main teaching hospitals in Winnipeg (either St. Boniface or HSC). Specifically, for physicians working in community hospitals, community practice, rural and remote areas who demonstrate a strong commitment to medical education. Nomination may be from resident physicians registered with PARIM. To nominate a staff physician, please fill out the nomination form with a brief letter of explanation (350 words maximum) describing why the nominee merits recognition. This paragraph should outline specific examples of the staff physicians merits that meet the award criteria.

Selection: Selection is completed by the PARIM Awards Committee on an annual basis.


Criteria for Selection:

2. Demonstrates clinical expertise and evidence based approach to resident education
3. Embodies or integrates the CanMeds roles
4. Strong record of integrating ethics and professionalism to residency education
5. Evidence of effective leadership and mentorship ability.
