Selection: Selection is completed by the PARIM Awards Committee on an annual basis.

4. Honesty and integrity in all aspects of work and education
5. Adherence to professional standards of the University and workplace
6. Commitment to their professional development and excellence in their specialty
7. Prioritization of patient safety
8. Strong appreciation for PHIA and the importance of confidentiality
9. Appreciation for professional boundaries
10. Attendance to potential conflicts of interest
11. Understanding of own wellness and limits, both professionally and personally
