Good afternoon,

Further to the email sent on June 2, 2020, we have since been in touch with CPSM, CMPA and PARIM and would like to provide the following clarifications related to your CMPA and CPSM renewal.

CPSM confirmed that a renewal email was sent to all PGME trainees. Associate members who have not received a renewal email from the College should contact renewals@cpsm.mb.ca as a username provided in the email is required to access the renewal website. The renewals mailbox is monitored and CPSM ensures a quick response to those inquiries. PGME will receive notification directly from CPSM once you have renewed your membership.

CMPA has confirmed that if no changes are required to your type of work, province of work and your method of payment is monthly or annual direct debit there is no action required for renewing trainees. Your CMPA membership will be renewed automatically. If your method of payment is online fee payment you are required to submit your payment by July 1, you should contact your financial institution for instructions on setting up payees as this process may differ from one institution to another. A member number is required when setting up the CMPA as a payee. Invoicing for 2021, will occur in November 2020. PGME receives confirmation of registration from CMPA daily.

CMPA PAYMENT UPDATE FROM PARIM:

All residents should have all received email information from PGME about the new method for CMPA payments. PARIM would like to assist you in this process and hopefully the following information will help answer any questions you may have.

CMPA has changed their pay structure. ALL residents in Canada now need to pay directly to CMPA. **The amount that Manitoba residents have to pay has NOT changed.** Shared Health is responsible for 75% and residents are responsible for 25% (up to a maximum of \$625) of the payment.

All Manitoba residents (as defined in the PARIM Collective Agreement) are currently insured until the end of this academic year, June 30, 2020.

1. You must log in to your online CMPA account. Go to the "MY MEMBERSHIP" tab - Fees and Payments - Payment Methods - Select your preferred payment method (MONTHLY/ANNUAL pre-authorized direct debit or Annual online fee payment which is payable through your banking).

2. ANNUAL OPTION

- a. CMPA only provides annual invoicing based on the calendar year. Therefore, if you

have chosen the ANNUAL direct debit CMPA will require 6 months' worth of payment as a lump sum in July 2020 (provides membership from July to December 2020). Starting January 1, 2021, CMPA will require 12 months' worth of payment as a lump sum in January 2021. There are 2 options for annual payment – Annual direct debit and Annual online fee payment.

Annual direct debit: Your banking information can be updated at any time through CMPA's member portal. CMPA will debit 6 months' worth of payment as a lump sum in July 2020 and then, starting January 2021 and every year afterwards it will debit 12 months.

Annual online fee payment (OFP). The CMPA offers its members the option to pay their annual fee through their banking institution. You will need to select this payment method through the CMPA member portal and then make your payment to CMPA through your banking institution using online banking – for 6 months by July 1, 2020 and for 12 months by January 1, 2021.

3. MONTHLY OPTION

- a. Monthly direct debit: Your banking information can be updated at any time through CMPA's member portal. CMPA will debit one months' worth of payment on the 20th each month from your bank account starting July 20th 2020.
4. Once you receive your receipt of payment, email the receipt to pmao-residents@sharehealthmb.ca . Please note that you can obtain a Statement of Account by signing into the CMPA member portal, however monthly payments will only show as paid once the monthly payment is completed.
5. According to CMPA, the annual fee for Residents and Fellows in Manitoba for the 6 months is \$882 or \$147/month. Please see PDF here <https://www.cmpa-acpm.ca/static-assets/pdf/membership/fees-and-payment/2020cal-e.pdf>

In accordance with the PARIM Collective Agreement, **residents will be reimbursed whether you choose the annual or monthly pay option. However, the timing of the reimbursement will depend on your method of payment.**

Good Morning,

Please review important information below as it relates to your continued training at the University of Manitoba.

RE: College of Physicians and Surgeons of Manitoba (CPSM) & Canadian Medical Protective Association (CMPA)

The PGME Office will confirm that each trainee is licensed with the CPSM and is covered by liability insurance through the CMPA, or their equivalent organization for non-medical learners prior to being registered with the University of Manitoba in Aurora student.

Trainees on an educational license should have received their renewal notification directly from CPSM on Friday, May 29, 2020. We are asking all trainees to renew their CPSM license **immediately**. This allows time for your application to be processed by CPSM, documented by PGME, and allows your Program to add you to the call schedule for June 1 as per PARIM – WRHA Collective Agreement.

CMPA has made changes to the way in which it will accept payment for its services, beginning with our academic year of July 1, 2020 – June 30, 2021. CMPA is now requiring Residents to submit payments for their own liability insurance (in other words, no third party payments from Shared Health). They are providing Residents with the choice of paying in one lump sum for the entire year, or in monthly payments. The PGME office receives weekly reports from CMPA confirming registration. Please ensure you registration and submit your payment prior to June 5, 2020 to ensure PGME can reconfirm your registration. Additional information including how to submit for reimbursement is in the attached email.
